**Notice of adoption of the Houses in Multiple  
Occupation Supplementary Planning Document  
(SPD20)**

On the 13 September 2022 Kingston upon Hull City Council adopted the Houses in Multiple Occupation Supplementary Planning Document (SPD20). The adopted SPD provides guidance on Policy 7 Houses in Multiple Occupation, Part 2 (a), of the Hull Local Plan 2016 to 2032. The SPD provides advice on avoiding concentrations of houses in multiple occupation (HMOs) and safeguarding residential amenity.
