**Notice of adoption of the City Centre Parking  
Strategy Supplementary Planning Document  
(SPD5)**

On the 30<sup>th</sup> October 2019 Kingston upon Hull City Council adopted the City Centre Parking Strategy Supplementary Planning Document (SPD5). The adopted SPD provides guidance on Policy 10 City Centre Mixed Use Sites, Policy 26(b)(vii) Location and Layout of Development, Policy 30(1/2/3/4/7/8) New Parking Sites, Policy 31(1/2/3/4) City Centre Car Parking, Policy 32(1/2) Parking Standards, Policy 36(3) Walking, Cycling and Powered Two-Wheelers, Policy 47 Atmospheric Pollution of the Hull Local Plan 2016 to 2032. This SPD has been prepared to guide applicants through the planning process to ensure that Hull's physical environment is not harmed by a planning proposal and that any significant adverse impacts of a development scheme are addressed at the most appropriate stage of the planning process.
