


How to enable pop ups

Chrome

Turn pop-ups on or off



1. On your computer, open Chrome.
2. At the top right, click More  > Settings.
3. Under "Privacy and security," click **Site settings**.
4. Click **Pop-ups and redirects**.
5. At the top, turn the setting to **Allowed** or **Blocked**.

Internet Explorer

Select the Tools icon and then “**Internet** Options”. Click into the “Privacy” tab and click “**Settings**” beside **Turn on Pop-up Blocker**.


Android users

Turn pop-ups on or off

1. On your Android phone or tablet, open the Chrome app .
2. To the right of the address bar, tap More  **Settings**.
3. Tap **Site settings** > **Pop-ups and redirects**.
4. Turn **Pop-ups and redirects** on or off.




Allow pop-ups from a specific site

Not all pop-ups are ads or spam. Some legitimate websites display web content in pop-up windows.

1. On your Android phone or tablet, open the Chrome app .
2. Go to a page where pop-ups are blocked.
3. At the bottom, tap **Always show**.


iPhone & iPad users

Turn pop-ups on or off

1. On your iPhone or iPad, open the Chrome app .
2. Tap More  > Settings .
3. Tap **Content Settings** > **Block Pop-ups**.
4. Turn **Block Pop-ups** on or off.

Allow pop-ups for a specific site

Not all pop-ups are ads or spam. Some legitimate websites display web content in pop-up windows.

1. On your iPhone or iPad, open the Chrome app .
2. Go to a page where pop-ups are blocked.
3. At the bottom, under "Pop-ups blocked," tap **Always show**.

Fix issues with pop-ups

If you're on a page with a pop-up or dialog that won't go away, try these steps:

1. Turn on your phone's airplane mode.
2. Quit Google Chrome.
3. Close the tab with the bad pop-up or dialog box.
