The types of information we process, including sensitive personal data-

- names, address and contact details
- family and household information
- details about health and maternity
- details of other professionals working with you such as GPs or midwives

We process personal data to deliver our functions as a local authority and offer support to families to help them live a healthier lifestyle.

We process personal data in accordance with GDPR conditions 6(1)(e) and 9(2)(g) in order to deliver tasks in the public interest as a Local Authority.

We obtain information from -

- our staff working directly with you
- the Council social care system
- instructors who provide the activity sessions to you
- NHS or GPs where you have asked them to contact us

We will keep your personal information safe and confidential but we may share it where-

- our instructors need your details in order to deliver a session
- any person may be at risk of harm if the information is not shared
- it is necessary to prevent, detect, investigate or punish a crime
- in order to defend a legal claim or complaint about our service

The information you provide is retained for up to two years
