Masterplan  
Supplementary Planning Document 6 (SPD 6)**

On Friday 10 September 2021, Kingston upon Hull City Council adopted the East Carr Masterplan, Supplementary Planning Document 6 (SPD6). The purpose of the adopted SPD is to outline the process, considerations, qualities, and opportunities that will help to deliver a high-quality residential development at East Carr. It promotes the processes that will lead to good design outcomes, and provides a clear understanding of the design approaches and requirements that are likely to be deemed acceptable in design and planning terms.
