

## Licensing Act 2003: Minor Variation of a Premises Licence

Brief Description of Proposed Variations:

- a) Reduce the hours of the supply of alcohol to be from 10:00 to 22:00 seven days a week.**
- b) Remove all seasonal and nonstandard times from the supply of alcohol.**
- c) Remove the following activities from the premises licence: exhibition of films, indoor sporting events, performance of live music, playing of recorded music, performance of dance and provision of late night refreshment in full.**
- d) Reduce the opening times of the premises to be from 10:00 to 22:00 seven days a week.**
- e) Add a condition: A minimum of four door supervisors shall be on duty at all times that the premises are open to the public.**
